Monitoring of policies and administrative procedures is an important function of school board governance and should be one of the highest priorities of the Annapolis Valley Regional School Board. Policies must continue to reflect the Board's mission, vision, guiding principles, belief statements, goals and values. Board members and senior staff must ensure that this monitoring process has ongoing and particular attention each year so that the policies and procedures remain relevant and practical. The monitoring process may include a revision of a policy and/or administrative procedure when necessary. When it is determined a review is necessary, those persons or groups that make the greatest use of particular policies must have input during the review process.

Monitoring

- The Superintendent of Schools is responsible for the implementation, monitoring and revision of this policy.
- This policy will be monitored annually.
