



Closure of Schools When Board-Provided Transportation is Cancelled Due to Adverse Weather or Road Conditions Board Policy

Department: Departments of Finance and Operations
Section: Operations - Transportation

The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board believes that when Board-provided transportation is cancelled, due to adverse weather or road conditions, schools will be closed to students, and scheduled classes and school activities will normally be cancelled. Closing particular counties may be used where practical as described in the administrative procedure AP 202.2.

The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board recognizes that winter driving conditions create a higher risk to safe travel and that extra care must be taken by drivers in getting students to and from school safely. Where the risk to students and drivers is judged, professionally, to be too high or may become too high because of road or forecast weather conditions, Board-provided transportation shall not operate.

Monitoring:

- The Director of Operations is responsible for the implementation, monitoring and revision of this policy.
- This policy will be monitored annually.
