The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board believes that French Immersion provides students a valuable opportunity to become functionally bilingual, while attaining learning outcomes in curriculum areas. The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board believes that Immersion is a viable option for all students.

Specifically:

- Each Immersion program must meet the requirements of the Department of Education.
- An Immersion program shall be considered for implementation where there is sufficient demand, as detailed in the administrative procedures.
- The Board will offer regional Immersion programs, for which students from the entire region may apply.
- Transportation for the student enrolled in an Immersion program in a school other than the student's community school shall be the responsibility of the student's parent/guardian.
- Where numbers warrant and funding permits, the Board shall provide a continuous French Immersion program through to the end of the secondary level.

Monitoring:

The Director of Programs and Services is responsible for the implementation, monitoring and revision of this policy.

This policy will be monitored annually.
