The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board recognizes there are students in schools who may be subject to life-threatening allergic reactions, specifically anaphylaxis.

Specifically:

- 1.0 Plans shall be put in place to maximize safety and minimize the risk of anaphylactic reactions among students including:
 - 1.1 Identifying students at risk
 - 1.2 Developing an Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan
 - 1.3 Provision of inservicing for applicable school staff
 - 1.4 Provision of educational awareness for school community
- 2.0 Anaphylaxis management is a shared responsibility that includes students with life-threatening allergies, their parent(s)/legal guardian(s), caregivers, and the entire school community.

Monitoring

- The Director of Programs and Services is responsible for the implementation, monitoring, and revision of this policy.
- This policy will be monitored annually.
